Items that will be considered for this exhibition include the following categories:

- A) **Quilts**—lap, twin, double or queen bed size
- B) **Quilted wall hangings**
- C) **Other quilted items**, such as purses, hot pads, bowls, etc.
- D) **Knitted items**—blankets, items of clothing, heirloom items, etc.
- E) **Crochet items** – blankets, items of clothing, heirloom items, etc.
- F) **Needlework**—crewel embroidery, needle point, counted cross stitch, etc.
- G) **Hand-made clothing**—heirloom hand sewing, smocking, appliqué, quilted, etc.

Guidelines:

1. Participating artist must be a member artist of **The Kelly**. Join at <http://www.thekelly.org>
2. Each artist may submit 2 entries in each category. They may be submitted by emailing photos of entries to thekelly36092@gmail.com or by mailing a jump drive to P. O Box 641, Wetumpka, AL 36092 by **December 10, 2020**.
3. Artists will be notified by email or phone call of items selected for this exhibition on or after **December 17, 2020**.
4. Each photo should be named as follows: **Title, Artist, Medium, Size, and Price**. Items not for sale should list price as **NFS** instead of price. Because of the length of time it takes to correct titles, **not naming each item properly will cause disqualification**.
5. Please include the entry form and Exhibition Agreement as part of the submission (email or mailing). If mailed, please include them on the jump drive or included in the envelope.
6. All entries must be handmade by the person entering or relative of that person (in the case of collectibles and antiques).
7. Clothing must be on a plastic hanger or displayed in a frame or other acceptable method.
8. Quilts must have a method for hanging, i.e., ties, sleeve & rod, clip, clamps, or loops. Consult curator if not sure.



- 9. Only the finest quality items will be chosen by the judges.
- 10. A twenty-five percent (25%) donation to **The Kelly** will be deducted from any sales during this exhibit. The 25% includes the costs of credit card fees. Price your items accordingly. **The Kelly** hopes to get a lot of press for this exhibit due to its uniqueness.

EXHIBITION AGREEMENT**

Name _____, hereafter referred to as the Exhibitor.

In consideration of The Kelly Fitzpatrick Memorial Gallery (The Kelly) and the Wetumpka Area Chamber of Commerce (Lessor) allowing the exhibitor, to exhibit artwork either online or on the premises of The Kelly's and lessor's property as a means of promoting the arts to the citizens of Wetumpka and the public, The Exhibitor, desiring to voluntarily participate in this Exhibit, does hereby acknowledge and agree as follows:

The Kelly has the right to deny the exhibition of any particular piece of art or artwork, if in its sole discretion, it is deemed unsuitable for any reason to be displayed online or on its property.

I understand and agree that The Kelly and the lessor do not warrant the safety or security of any artwork on display on said property, and I specifically agree to hold The Kelly and the lessor, their members, employees, officers, volunteers, and/or agents, harmless from any damages or claims for damages sustained to any artwork displayed on The Kelly's and/or lessor's property.

Knowing the risks of damage or loss that may occur to my artwork being displayed on The Kelly's property, which is open to the public, I voluntarily assume responsibility for any risk of property damage and/or loss that may be sustained as a result of participating in this Exhibit.

I do hereby authorize The Kelly, and their agents and assigns, to take and use photographs of my artwork for the purposes of preparing a catalog (either printed or on-line) and publicizing this event, in such manner and at such times as it deems appropriate. No other reproduction of the artwork is authorized.

Furthermore, I, individually and for my heirs and assigns, do voluntarily waive, release, hold harmless, discharge, and indemnify The Kelly and the lessor, from any and all claims that I, and/or my heirs or assigns, may have in the future, including but not limited to property damage, that I may incur as a result of my participation in the Exhibit, whether directly connected to these activities or not, however caused, or as a result of the condition of the premises where the Exhibit occurs.

Finally, I do hereby agree to remove my artwork from the Kelly's premises within 30 days from the last date of public display for the Exhibit. My failure to remove my artwork in 30 days shall mean that I have decided to convey the artwork to The Kelly as consideration for their displaying the art during the Exhibit. Should that event so occur, I do hereby grant, bargain, sell, and convey all my right, title, and interest in and to the artwork which is subject of this agreement unto the Kelly outright and in fee simple absolute, for them, their successors and assigns, to have and to hold forever, free from all contingencies and encumbrances thereon. This paragraph shall be null and void and of no force or effect should I remove my artwork within the allotted time following the end of the Exhibit.

I HAVE CAREFULLY READ THIS AGREEMENT AND FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS CONTENTS. I AM AWARE THAT THIS IS A RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND A CONTRACT BETWEEN ME AND THE KELLY AND ITS LESSOR.
