We will accept a variety of artists including, but not limited to fine art, textiles, pottery, photography, jewelry, metal, wood and more! We also welcome vendors focused on wildlife, sporting life, and the great outdoors. If you fit in both categories, even better! Vendor Space Details

Spaces are 10' x 10' and contained in a large central tent. Please let us know if you would like a table and chairs or if you prefer to use your own setup. We can provide a six-foot table and two chairs. We will also have a small number of spaces available outside of the main tent. These spaces are 12' x 12' and participants are responsible for their own white tent and materials. We will provide floaters to relieve vendors as needed throughout the event. Cost is 100.00 for each space reserved.

Please provide quality images and detailed descriptions of the type of pieces you will have available. Booth setup images are also encouraged.

All fees are non-refundable. In the unlikely event that the festival is cancelled, booth reservations will apply to a rescheduled date.
