## ABOUT THE EXHIBIT:

We are pleased to announce our fifth annual “Art Gone Wild” art exhibition, celebrating our native wildlife and field sports through the arts. We invite artists and collectors alike to submit artworks of any medium featuring southeastern native wildlife, field sporting life, and regional outdoor wildlife pursuits.

## ARTWORK RULES:

1. **THEME:** Entries must fit the theme of native southeastern wildlife and/or field sports. Please note that THIS IS NOT THE COMPETITION; Art Gone Wild will coincide with the Alabama Wildlife Fine Art Competition from Sept 25<sup>th</sup> - Nov 13<sup>th</sup>.
2. **ORIGINALITY:** Artwork should be exclusively created by the submitting artist(s) from a concept or composition originally conceived by that artist(s) from draft to completion. If using copyrighted, licensed, or other reference materials (including permissive use or reference photos not owned by you), please refer to our “Originality and Copyright Infringement Rules” (page 2) for specific guidelines and restrictions.
3. **READY TO HANG:** 2D artworks must be either framed or gallery-wrapped (at least an inch thick with the edges painted, not raw), and all 2D artworks must have gallery wire installed for hanging. Artwork that does not fit this criteria will not be accepted.

## EXHIBITION GUIDELINES:

1. **ENTRIES:** Each artist may submit up to four (4) entries and must submit a photo of each entry with their application for review. This is a juried show, and these wildlife art exhibitions are The Kelly’s most popular shows of the year. Therefore, please understand that space is limited and not everyone will have pieces chosen. Applications must be received by August 16, 2026 to be considered for this exhibition.
2. **FEES:** There are no submission fees. There is a flat rate fee of \$25 per artist if your submission(s) is/are accepted, which is due upon Drop Off. However, entry fees are **WAIVED** for membered Kelly artists of any membership level. Memberships are available for as low as \$50 a year (starting from your donation date), so if you intend to enter multiple exhibitions, we encourage you to consider becoming a Kelly member.
3. **HOW TO APPLY:** Applications, labeled photos, and optional didactic texts (up to 50 words per artwork) may be:

  - Mailed to PO Box 641, Wetumpka AL 36092, or
  - Dropped off into the Registrar’s receiving box at our office at 301 Hill Street, Wetumpka.Entries received any other way are NOT considered valid. This includes entries sent via text, Facebook messenger, or any other delivery method. Please ensure your artwork photos are high quality, well-lit, in frame, and labeled with your name and the artwork title.
4. **NOTIFICATION:** Artists will be notified by email by August 21st if they have been accepted or not and which pieces.
5. **ART DROP OFF:** Art **MUST** be delivered to The Kelly at 301 Hill Street, Wetumpka, AL 36092 on Sept 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup>. Please only bring the accepted artworks. The Kelly reserves the right to refuse any artwork that does not match the submitted entry, has unpainted edges, and/or does not have gallery wire installed (if 2D). Late deliveries will not be accepted, so please contact us beforehand if you need to make other arrangements.
6. **COMMISSION:** A twenty-five percent (25%) donation to The Kelly will be deducted from any sales during this exhibit. If you have any pieces that are for display only and not to be sold, please notate clearly on the application form.
7. **ART PICK UP:** Artwork that has not been sold should be picked up on Nov 14<sup>th</sup> & Nov 16<sup>th</sup>. If you or an authorized person are unable to pick up on that date, please contact us to make alternate arrangements. Any artwork not removed within 90 days from the pickup date - February 16<sup>th</sup> - shall be considered an unrestricted donation to The Kelly.

### ORIGINALITY AND COPYRIGHT INFRINGEMENT RULES

- ORIGINALITY:** Artwork should be exclusively created by the submitting artist(s) from a concept or composition originally conceived by that artist(s) from draft to completion. If using copyrighted, licensed, or other reference materials, please refer to the language below for specific guidelines and restrictions.
- COPYRIGHT INFRINGEMENT:** Copyright infringement of any kind is not acceptable. This would include artwork produced using imagery or materials from someone else's creation (drawings, paintings, photographs, artwork created with classroom instruction, etc.) without the original artist/owner's express written permission.
  - Permissive Use and Credit:** If your artwork is the result of permissive use of someone else's creation or instruction, the artwork must include credit to the original artist and/or copyright holder, such as: "Study of Jane Smith's Still Life Painting" or "Image Credit: iStock/Getty Images" or "Workshop Credit: John Doe."
  - The requirement for either written permission or imagery credit does not apply to:
    - Historical photographs (generally 50+ years ago, unless the original photographer or their estate renewed the copyright),
    - Works within public domain,
    - Images with the Creative Commons Zero designation, or
    - Per "Fair Use" doctrines, transformative works.
- ACCEPTABLE REFERENCE PHOTO USAGE:** Artists may use their own photos or reference materials without restriction. Artists using other sources of reference materials should ensure that they are using ethically-sourced materials that are free of copyright, royalty, or other intellectual property rights. No direct copies of reference images are allowed, unless the artist provides The Kelly with proof of permission or proof of licensing purchase from the copyright owner.

The Kelly will consider artwork using stock or reference images as transformative – and thus does not need to be credited – if the artist:

- Significantly alters the artwork's final composition from the original reference photo, to be judged on a case-by-case basis. Generally, artwork should deviate from a single reference photo by at least 50%; OR,
- Appreciably alter the artwork's final composition using multiple different reference materials to create an entirely original composition.

- AI USAGE:** Artwork or reference imagery generated by Artificial Intelligence (AI) are not permitted. Entry/submission photos or digital art enhanced by AI are also not permitted.

In consideration of The Kelly Fitzpatrick Center for the Arts (hereafter referred to as The Kelly) allowing the exhibitor to exhibit artwork either online or on the premises of The Kelly as a means of promoting the arts to the citizens of Wetumpka and the public, The Exhibitor, desiring to voluntarily participate in this Exhibit, does hereby acknowledge and agree as follows:

The Kelly has the right to deny the exhibition of any particular piece of art or artwork, if in its sole discretion, it is deemed unsuitable for any reason to be displayed online or on its property.

The Kelly will insure the Object(s) under its Fine Arts Insurance policy wall-to-wall for the amount specified on the attached inventory against all risks of physical loss or damage from external causes on location during the period of this loan; provided, however, that if the Object(s) shall have been industrially fabricated or fabricated with industrially manufactured parts, and can be replaced to the artist's specifications, the amount of insurance shall be limited to the cost of replacement. If no value is listed on the reverse side, maximum coverage shall be the fair market value of the Object(s) at the time of loss or damage as determined by an appraisal from a mutually agreed upon expert.

The Kelly's insurance policy contains the standard exclusions for loss or damage due to war, invasion, hostilities, rebellion, insurrection, confiscation by order of any government or public authority, risks of contraband or illegal transportation and/or trade, nuclear damage, wear and tear, gradual deterioration, moths, vermin and inherent vice, and for damage sustained due to and resulting from any repairing, restoration or retouching process unless caused by fire and/or explosion. The Kelly is not responsible for prior damage nor damage incurred from material defects present prior to physical receipt and acceptance of the artwork by The Kelly.

The Exhibitor agrees that, in the event of loss or damage, recovery shall be limited to such amount, if any, as may be paid by the insurer, hereby releasing The Kelly, each of the Participating Kellys, and the trustees, officers, agents, and employees of The Kelly and any Participating Kellys from liability for any and all claims arising out of such loss or damage.

If the Exhibitor chooses to maintain their own insurance, The Kelly must be supplied with a certificate of insurance naming The Kelly and each of the participating locations as an additional insured or waiving subrogation against The Kelly and each of the participating locations. If the Exhibitor shall fail to supply The Kelly with such a certificate, this loan agreement shall constitute a release of The Kelly and each of the Participating Kellys from any liability in connection with the Object(s).

The Kelly is not responsible for any error or information deficiency furnished to the Exhibitor's insurer or for any lapses in coverage. The Kelly will not be liable for any misrepresentation of ownership or attribution. Government regulations will be adhered to in international shipments. As a rule, each party is responsible for adhering to its country's import/export requirements.

The Exhibitor does hereby authorize The Kelly, and their agents and assigns, to take and use photographs of their artwork for the purposes of preparing a catalog (either printed or on-line) and publicizing this event, in such manner and at such times as it deems appropriate. No other reproduction of the artwork is authorized.

Furthermore, the Exhibitor, individually and their heirs and assigns, does voluntarily waive, release, hold harmless, discharge, and indemnify The Kelly, from any and all claims that the Exhibitor and/or their heirs or assigns, may have in the future, including but not limited to property damage, that the Exhibitor may incur as a result of their participation in the Exhibit, whether directly connected to these activities or not, however caused, or as a result of the condition of the premises where the Exhibit occurs.

Finally, the Exhibitor does hereby agree to remove their artwork from The Kelly's premises within 90 days from the last date of public display for the Exhibit. The Exhibitor's failure to remove their artwork in 90 days shall mean that they have decided to convey the artwork to The Kelly as consideration for their displaying the art during the Exhibit. Should that event so occur, the Exhibitor does hereby grant, bargain, sell, and convey all their right, title, and interest in and to the artwork which is subject of this agreement unto The Kelly outright and in fee simple absolute, for them, their successors and assigns, to have and to hold forever, free from all contingencies and encumbrances thereon. This paragraph shall be null and void and of no force or effect should the Exhibitor remove their artwork within the allotted time following the end of the Exhibit.

**I, THE EXHIBITOR, HAVE CAREFULLY READ THIS AGREEMENT AND FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS CONTENTS. I AM AWARE THAT THIS IS A RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND A CONTRACT BETWEEN ME AND THE KELLY.**

I, the exhibitor, am over the age of nineteen and am signing this Agreement voluntarily and of my own free will, fully intending to be bound by its terms.
